Graham Stirk is a senior partner at Rogers Stirk Harbour + Partners, having first joined the practice in 1983 when it was

CHET ZAR: I LIKE TO PAINT MONSTERS

Despite his success in the film industry, Zar became disenchanted by the many artistic compromises required of him. With the support of his family and horror author Clive Barker, Zar decided in early 2000 to pursue his passion for monsters by painting them. For centuries, cod was like gold, driving men to extremes. Cod were so abundant in the waters off New England that

fishermen used to say they could walk across the Atlantic on the backs of them, and generations of men from places like Gloucester and Cape Cod spent their entire lives chasing the coveted fish.

In recent decades, something began to change in the Gulf of Maine. As the region's cod catch plummeted, government surveys of the iconic species reported increasingly dire results. In 2016, officials estimated there were fewer than 200 cod fishermen left in the fleet, and they're now in the fight of their lives, struggling to hold fast to a tradition that has endured for centuries in New England.

BRITISH PHARMACOPOEIA

- is published every year in August
- becomes effective on 1 January of the following year
- incorporates all the monographs and texts of the Ph. Eur.

British Pharmacopoeia (Veterinary)

The BP (Vet) also incorporates monographs and texts of the European Pharmacopoeia.

The Ph. Eur. Is published by the European Directorate for the Quality of Medicines & HealthCare.

The European Pharmacopoeia Commission is responsible for the publication of the Ph. Eur. The UK is a member of the EP Commission and is involved at all stages of Ph. Eur. Monograph development.
